The chair's teaching curriculum encompasses courses at Bachelor's and Master's level in both German and English. As the ideal candidate you have completed a Master's degree in Economics with distinction, preferably with a focus on empirical research methods or public finance. Furthermore, you are driven to pursue research and are highly motivated to work in empirical economics. Applicants in the final stages of their Master's program are also welcome to apply.

You also have the opportunity to work on third-party funded projects. Pay grades are set according to TV-L E 13 (German public service remuneration). The positions are initially set for a duration of three years, with the option to extend for two additional years.
